



## Bullying Lesson: Something Nice for Everyone

Week 1 • Day 4 Innovation Station

**National Reading Standards:**

**Materials:** Paper, Pencils

### What Children Learn

To demonstrate oral language skills

To apply listening skills

To write words



### What to Do

1. Have the children list the name of every child in the class on their papers. (For younger learners, pair them with an older child who can write the names. If the group is large, break into smaller groups and have them list each member of the group.)
2. Tell them to write a compliment (something nice) about each person next to his or her name on the list. (As a variation of this activity, you could ask them to sit in a circle as each child says something nice about the other children orally.)
3. When they are finished, the children should read each list aloud.
4. Tell the children that as they hear a compliment about themselves, they should look at their friend and say, "Thank you."

**Extension:** If time allows, have the children continue exchanging compliments around the circle.
